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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 70 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES", BY AMENDING ARTICLE XIII ENTITLED "MOBILE BILLBOARDS" BY AND SECTION 70-803 AMENDING ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS" PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West finds that mobile billboard advertisement serves as a distraction to other drivers of motor vehicles, bicycles and vessels on the densely occupied streets and waters off of Key West; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West further finds that this regulation is a permissible time, place and manner on commercial speech pursuant to *Showing Animals Respect and Kindness et. Al. v City of Hollywood*, 166 Cal. App. 4th 815, Court of Appeal 2nd Dist., Div.1, California, 2008.: and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Article XIII, Section 70-803 is hereby amended in the Code of Ordinances as follows*:

CHAPTER 70 - TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

* * * * *

ARTICLE XIII. - MOBILE BILLBOARDS IN GENERAL

Sec. 70-803. - Definitions.

Mobile billboard advertising is any advertising of a business, goods, or services for which the mobile billboard owner or operator does not hold a majority ownership interest in that is displayed on a bicycle, vehicle, motor vehicle or vessel that carries, conveys, pulls or transports any sign or billboard for the primary purpose of advertising.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as

reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
