Public Comment

Members of the public wishing to be heard on a proposition before Council must submit a written request to speak to the City Clerk's Office.

To provide public comment, determine the type of appearance you wish to make:

- 1. Consent Agenda Item: Council meets in session prior to the Council meeting to discuss the upcoming agenda. The Agenda Review meeting is the only designated time for public input on Consent Agenda items. During the Agenda Review meeting, you may speak once and address all your remarks regarding Items A-K and Items 4-6 (CRA/NID/OPEB). Live, or Written comments in advance, may be provided. Requests to speak must be submitted by 9 a.m. on the day of the meeting.
- 2. **Public Hearings**: Your comment must relate to a public hearing as noted on the agenda and may be addressed at the Council meeting during discussion of that specific agenda item. Live, or Written comments in advance, may be provided.
- 3. **General Appearance**: Items that are unrelated to a specific agenda item but are matters pertinent to the City may be addressed at General Appearances. Only live comments may be provided. **Requests to speak must be submitted by 9 a.m. on the day of the meeting.** Note: General appearances are limited to 3 minutes each, although if there are a large number of requests to speak, Council may reduce the time allocated for each speaker.
