CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA ORDINANCE NO. 2025-_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, SECTION 1.01, "DEFINITIONS," TO PROVIDE FOR A DEFINITION OF "INDEPENDENT SANCTIONING AUTHORITY" AND "ATHLETIC COACHES", REMOVE THE DEFINITION OF "SPORTS LEAGUE OFFICIAL;" AND AMENDING SECTION 100.11, "BACKGROUND CHECKS," TO REVISE THE BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIREMENTS FOR ATHLETIC COACHES TO CONFORM TO STATE LAW; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, First, the City Commission desires to amend the City Code by revising the background checks requirements for Sports League Officials to conform to recent revisions to state law; and

WHEREAS, Second, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the City to adopt this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent and factual findings underlying this Ordinance.

Section 2. Amendment to Chapter 1.

Chapter 1, "Definitions," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Weston is amended to read as follows:

§ 1.01 DEFINITIONS.

INDEPENDENT SANCTIONING AUTHORITY. a private, nongovernmental entity that organizes, operates, or coordinates a youth athletic team in this State if the team includes one or more minors and is not affiliated with a private school, as defined in F.S. § 1002.01.

LEVEL 2 BACKGROUND CHECK. A background check as described in F.S. §-435.04 943.0438.

SPORTS LEAGUE OFFICIAL. ATHLETIC COACHES. Any Person who is authorized by a sports league to work, whether for compensation or as a volunteer, in (a) a position of, or in a position with substantially similar duties as, a coach, assistant coach, trainer, team manager, referee, officer or board member, or (b) any other position for 10 or more hours within a Year and has direct contact with one or more minors participants in a sports league at City facilities, courts or playing fields. person authorized by an Independent Sanctioning Authority to work as a coach, assistant coach, manager, or referee, whether for compensation or as a volunteer, for a youth athletic team based in Florida; and has direct contact with one or more minors on the youth athletic team.

Section 3. Amendment to Chapter 100.

Chapter 100, "Public Parks, Recreation and Special Events," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Weston is amended to read as follows:

§ 100.11 BACKGROUND CHECKS.

trainers and officers or board members of the sports leagues shall be required to undergo background checks.; provided, however, this requirement shall only apply to Sports League Officials eighteen years and older. The local level-governing-board-Independent Sanctioning Authority of the sports league shall ensure that such background checks are conducted. The local governing board of the sports league may not delegate this responsibility to an individual team and may not authorize any Person to act as a Sports-League Official an Athletic Coach or participate as a trainer, or officer or board member, unless a Level 2 Background Check is conducted that does not result in disqualification for any of the following offenses defined in F.S. § 435.04(2)., unless the Sports-League Official has been adjudicated not guilty of all such offenses:

100.11(A)(1) All sex offenses regardless of the amount of time since the offense (examples include child molestation, rape, sexual assault, sexual battery, sodomy, prostitution, solicitation, indecent exposure or similar offenses).

100.11(A)(2) All felony offenses involving violence regardless of the amount of time since the offense—(examples—include—murder, manslaughter, aggravated—assault, kidnapping, robbery, aggravated burglary).

100.11(A)(3) All felony offenses other than violence or sex offenses within the past ten years (examples include drug offenses, theft, embezzlement, fraud, child endangerment).

100.11(A)(4) All misdemeanor violence offenses within the past seven years (examples include simple assault, battery, domestic violence, hit and run).

100.11(A)(5) Two misdemeanor drug or alcohol offenses within the past ten years (examples include driving under the influence, simple drug possession, drunk and disorderly conduct, public intexication, possession of drug paraphernalia).

100.11(A)(6) Any other misdemeanor within the past five years that would be considered a potential danger to children or is directly related to the functions of that volunteer (examples include contributing to the delinquency of a minor, providing alcohol to a minor, theft—if the volunteer is to handle money).

100.11(B) *Type of background check*. A Level 2 Background Check that identifies an individual's entire criminal history shall be conducted in accordance with F.S. § 943.0438 and all other applicable law.

100.11(C)) *Frequency of background checks.* Every adult who is new to a City youth sports league shall be subject to an initial background check that shall be completed prior to that adult's involvement in any capacity. A background check shall be conducted annually-in accordance with F.S. § 943.0438 this Section and all other applicable law.

100.11(D) **Responsibility for payment of costs.** All background check related costs shall be the sole responsibility of the league. In the event that an <u>Sports League Official</u> Athletic Coach, trainer <u>or officer or board member</u> is involved in more than one sports league, the respective leagues should work together to share the costs in a mutually beneficial manner.

100.11(E) *Notification regarding compliance*. Prior to the commencement of each Year's practice season, the local level governing board of the league shall submit written certification to the City that the league has complied with the City's requirements regarding background checks on all Sports-League-Officials-Athletic Coaches, trainers or officers or board members. The certifying document shall be signed by the presiding officer of the local level governing board of the league. Should an adult commence participation in the league after the commencement of the practice season, the league shall, as soon as reasonably possible, submit a supplemental certifying document regarding a background check on the new adult participant. The certifying document shall read as follows:

"In accordance with and pursuant to Chapter 100 of the City of Weston Code, the (League Name) hereby certifies that it has complied with the City's requirements regarding background checks on all **Sports-League-Officials** Athletic Coaches, trainers or officers or board members."

100.11(F) **Responsibility of records maintenance, ownership, and control.** Maintenance, ownership, and control of all background check records and information generated, received, possessed and stored shall be the sole responsibility of the league, and shall be retained for a period of at least five Years in accordance with F.S. § 943.0438 and all other applicable law.

100.11(G) Failure to pass a Level 2 Background Check. Any Sports League Official Athletic Coach, trainer or officer or board member who has not passed a criminal background check, in accordance with F.S. § 943.0438, this Section and all other applicable law, is prohibited from functioning in an official capacity until such time as the process has been successfully completed. Any sports league that is found to be in violation of this Section is subject to a suspension or revocation of its facilities use permit.

Section 4. Codification.

It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance become and be made part of the City Code, and that the Sections of this Ordinance and Code may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section" or such other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish such intentions.

Section 5. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 6. Conflict.

That all Sections or parts of Sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, and all Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. Effective Date.

PASSED ON FIRST READING

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and adoption; and all Persons shall comply with the requirements of this Ordinance retroactive from January 1, 2025.
